#### Two in-depth Conferences on the History of International Criminal Law

The Forum for International Criminal and Humanitarian Law is pleased to announce two conferences on "The Historical Origins of International Criminal Law", in Hong Kong on 1-2 March and New Delhi on 29-30 November 2014. The Hong Kong conference examines historical trials and events up to the post-World War II period. The New Delhi conference follows up by studying later trials, doctrinal foundations, and institutional contributions to international criminal law. Each conference is held over two days, with leading judges, prosecutors, lawyers, and academics among the speakers, including LIU Daqun, Agnieszka Klonowiecka-Milart, David Re, ONUMA Yasuaki, Geoffrey Robertson, LING Yan, William Schabas, FURUYA Shuichi and David Cohen. The papers by 84 conference speakers, from more than 30 countries, will subsequently be published in two comprehensive volumes.
